April Fun Fly 04/07/2018

It is time to shake off the winter blues and enjoy our first Fun Fly of the year which will take place on Saturday April 7th.

We are trying something different this time. We call it LIMBO. No you don't have to lean way back and cripple your back. Let your airplane do the work for you. The idea is to fly low under a ribbon stretched across the runway on long poles. The initial height will be set at 20 ft. (open for discussion). If you manage to fly through you pass on to the next round. If you touch down after passing under the ribbon you get 10 points and that's it. If you cut the ribbon you also get 10 points but we don't want you to cut the ribbon since it has to be replaced. The flyers who pass through the gap move on to the second round. The ribbon will be lowered by 5 feet and they will have a second attempt. If there are more than one pilot still left in the running a final attempt will be with the ribbon set at 10 ft. high. Any who pass through on this attempt will share first place. Points will be as per other fun fly's. i.e. 50 for first, 40 for second and 30 for third.

This is intended to be a fun fly so let us have fun. Any disputes will be handled by the Fun Fly Committee and decisions will be final.

I realize that this is new to all of us so we should discuss the details at our March club meeting and make any agreed upon modifications.
