# Gym Stik Rebuild

Stay at home is an excuse for building, so I revamped my 27 inch wing span version of Gene Bond's Gym Stik. The AEO C10 motor was running at about its limit to keep the 6 ounce plane flying. My test of this 8 gram motor with a 5X3 prop showed it turning about 11000 RPM on about 24 watts input, consistent with the Heads-Up RC test. Calculated thrust from AdamOne website was about 4 ounces. The nose was a bit battered from hard stalls, but the rest of the plane was in good shape.

I had a bit bigger AEO motor that I bought at a swap meet for \$10, but it had no markings or specs. It weighs 16 g, so I went to the AEO website to find a match in their current offerings. The AEO MF-1904-2500 has matching weight and looks about the same. With a 6X3 prop, it turns about 12000 RPM on 2S using about 45 Watts input to give nearly 8 ounces of thrust, according to the AEO table. So all I needed to do was get a right sized fire wall and ESC. I won a 7A Electrifly ESC in the club raffle, so that part was done. A piece of lite-ply left over from a Midwest trainer kit provided the new firewall. I filled in the broken foam behind the firewall and I was done. First test of the motor with a 6X3 prop used 37 watts at full throttle on 2S, so power was likely as I figured. Thrust at the measured 12000 RPM should be nearly 8 ounces. Weight was up to about 7 ounces with a 600 mAh 2S battery, but not a problem with a 1.3 square foot wing. Just need The Yard to open again for flying so I can test it.
